- Serengeti National park, known as the endless plain where is the start and ends of the Great Wildebeest migration.
- Ngorongoro Crater, one of the eight wonders destination in the world with a large caldera allows the live life of Wildlife and Human being together in the same area. And the only place you can discover all the big five animals in a day.

Tarangire is most known as the home of more massive elephants among all Tanzania National Parks, also is famous of its savannah that allows and grew a bigger tree "Baobab trees" which natural used by elephants to provide water from their bark.

DAY 2	NGORONGORO CRATER TOUR	20th Feb 2020
After early breakfast depart for Ngorongoro crater, arriving in time for lunch. Afternoon game drive on the floor of the crater. After game drive will drive to Simba Camp for dinner and overnight. Ngorongoro's caldera shelters the most beautiful wildlife haven on earth. The rich pasture and permanent water of the Crater floor supports a resident population of some 20,000 to 25,000 large mammals. They are not confined by the Crater walls and can leave freely; they stay because conditions are favorable. Since most of the Crater floor is grassland, grazing animals predominate: gnu, zebra, gazelles, buffalo, eland and kongoni (Coke's hartebeest) and warthogs. The swamp and forest provide additional resources for hippos, some of Tanzania's last remaining black rhinos, giant-tusked elephants, waterbucks, reedbucks and bushbucks, baboons and vavets
